Correction exams for Midterms 1, 2 and 3:

Original score: X (max 50) Correction score C (max 50)

Total midterm score: ME (also max 50):

If C≤X, ME=X

If C>X, ME=X+0.3*(C-X)

Final percentage formula for final average calculation:

$$\% \, \text{Total} = 25\% \cdot \left(\frac{HW + BP}{HW_{maximum}}\right) + 40\% \cdot \left(\frac{total \, of \, best \, two \, midterm \, exams}{100}\right) + 35\% \cdot \left(\frac{FE}{100}\right)$$

 $HW_{maximum}$ is the maximum possible number of homework points excluding the points earned via the bonus questions, BP. So, HW+BP can be larger than $HW_{maximum}$.
