Correction exam for Midterm:

Original score: X (max 50)

Correction score C (max 50)

Total midterm score: ME (also max 50):

If C≤X. ME=X

If C>X, ME=X+0.3\*(C-X)

Final percentage formula for final average calculation:

% Total = 30% · 
$$\left(\frac{HW + BP}{HW_{maximum}}\right)$$
 + 30% ·  $\left(\frac{ME}{50}\right)$  + 40% ·  $\left(\frac{FE}{100}\right)$ 

 $HW_{maximum}$  is the maximum possible number of homework points excluding the points earned via the bonus questions, BP. So, HW+BP can be larger than  $HW_{maximum}$ .
