$$\% \text{Total} = 30\% \cdot \left(\frac{HW + BP}{HW_{maximum}}\right) + 30\% \cdot \left(\frac{ME}{50}\right) + 40\% \cdot \left(\frac{FE}{100}\right)$$

 $HW_{maximum}$ is the maximum possible number of homework points excluding the points earned via the bonus questions, *BP*. So, HW+BP can be larger than $HW_{maximum}$.
