Final percentage formula for final average calculation:
$\%$ Total $=25 \% \cdot\left(\frac{H W+B P}{H W_{\text {maximum }}}\right)+40 \% \cdot\left(\frac{\text { total of two midterm exams }}{100}\right)+35 \% \cdot\left(\frac{F E}{100}\right)$
$H W_{\text {maximum }}$ is the maximum possible number of homework points excluding the points earned via the bonus questions, $B P$. So, $H W+B P$ can be larger than $H W_{\text {maximum }}$.
