Infrastructure Planning and Facilities is asking for your assistance as we take the next step in service and sustainability. For the last few years, we have been transitioning away from desk side waste collection in favor of centralized recycling stations. This movement is following best practices already implemented by peer institutions over the last decade.

To make this change more convenient, MSU is offering the option of providing minibaskets that can be used to collect your non-recyclable landfill material, recycle.msu.edu/information/mini-basket/. Since nearly all waste is recyclable, the mini basket should be used to collect non-recyclable waste and your old waste basket can now be used as a recycling container. When the containers need to be emptied, take the material to any intermediate landfill or recycling container. Intermediate containers are the waste cans and recycling containers that are generally located in public areas such as copy rooms, hall ways and central office/reception areas.
